#### Mindful Mandala Making:

Sunday, January 17, 2021; 4:00-5:30 p.m.

**What:** Gather with Evie Waack and other friends for a 90-minute Mindful Art virtual gathering on Zoom. With "Mindful



Art" the emphasis is on the process of exploring rather than creating a finished product. Part of this exploration is making spontaneous marks on a sheet of paper, sort of like doodling.

Evie will help explore ways to create intuitive mindful mandalas through simple mark-making. Mandala is a Sanskrit word for circle. A simple writing prompt will provide a chance to respond to our mandalas.

Experience with art making NOT necessary. Experience with mindfulness NOT necessary.

What Material is Needed: Evie will deliver an envelope to each person. The envelope will include two sheets of multi-media paper, one sheet of lined paper and one black marker.

What you will need to have on hand: A pen or pencil for the writing prompt. If by chance, you want to include color, you could have something on hand for color (markers, pencils or crayons).
