Did you know Diane Highnam provided the salad for the Getting Ahead in the Cedar Valley dinner last month? There is a thank you from the program coordinator on our bulletin board for you to check out. Getting Ahead in the Cedar Valley is a nonprofit program of Bridges Out of Poverty which attempts to break the cycle of generational poverty. It operates on donations from churches & individuals plus grants from the Community Foundation of NE Iowa, Gaming Commission, and Guernsey Foundation. It started organizing in Waterloo in 2014 and had the first graduation in 2015. Since then there have been 111 grads from 11 groups, one group each spring & one each fall.

In 2020 classes could not be held because of Covid but have resumed in 2021. All sessions have been held at First United Methodist Church where headquarters are located. Since some participants have never had a 'graduation', the ceremony is made special by holding it at the Snowden House with a catered meal. Two of the co-founders are in Waterloo and continue to be involved as the program builds into the future. FCUCC has helped from the beginning through the Historic Church Row Coalition by supplying items for the meals served before the classes. It epitomizes the goals of the HCR as Lutherans, Catholics, Baptists, Methodists and Congregationalists all work together to improve our area.
